### Reimagine new ways to reuse materials creatively.

**Suggestion:** Use scraps, coffee filters, paper cups, foliage, Containers, cereal boxes, printed paper, or reclaimed wood. Or, reinterpret an existing art work and use it in a new way.

### Guidelines:

- Size for 2D work: Individual (max size 18x24)  
Group (max size 36X48)
- Self-standing 3D work can be any size.
- Mats preferred for 2 Dimensional work.
- Teachers' work should be ready to hang: framed, matted, etc. (**no glass**)
- Materials should be securely attached. Pastels, charcoal, or cray-pas must be well fixed.

**October 25<sup>th</sup>:** **Deadline** for electronic submission of student work. Email clear jpeg images of artwork. Each image should be saved as teacher’s last name, artist name (eg:teacherstudent.jpg) In the body of the email include name of teacher, school, and 50 word teacher written paragraph describing the project. Submit this form for each jpeg:
